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Annex 1 - Information on the processing of personal data

Information clause concerning the processing of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal of the EU L 119, p. 1) - hereinafter referred to as RODO - we inform you about the manner and purpose for which we process your personal data, as well as about your rights under RODO:

Your personal data will be processed in the framework of the project "Connect Poland Prize" carried out by Lubelski Park Naukowo - Technologiczny S.A. on the basis of agreement No. POIR.02.05.00-00-0011/20-00 under the Operational Programme Intelligent Development 2014-2020, Priority Axis 2: Support for the environment and business potential for R&D&I, Measure 2.5: Acceleration programmes - Poland Prize, co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund.
4. Your personal data will be processed for the purposes related to the recruitment, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the project, as well as in the scope necessary for the Administrator of Personal Data to fulfil their obligations towards the Managing Authority of the Polish Agency for Enterprise Development as an Intermediate Body under the Operational Programme Intelligent Development 2014-2020 grant for the implementation of the Project named "Connect Poland Prize" on the basis of Grant Agreement no POIR.02.05.00-00-0011/20-00.
5. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is art. 6 sec. 1 letter a) and f) RODO, i.e., consent granted for the processing of personal data and the legitimate interest of the Personal Data Administrator, understood as activities aimed at the proper implementation of The Project.
6. Giving consent and providing personal data is voluntary. However, refusing to provide such data will make it impossible to participate in the project and its meetings.

7. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Your withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of processing data, which was carried out on the basis of consent before the declaration of intent to withdraw it. The withdrawal of consent is tantamount to resignation from participation in the Project.
8. The recipients of your personal data may be entities cooperating with the Administrator in the framework of the project implementation and entities providing support services to the Administrator, such as external IT services, legal services and other entities with which the Administrator cooperates, but only for the purpose specified in point 3.3.
9. In connection with the implementation of the Project, your personal data may be processed outside the European Economic Area and the European Union.
10. You have the right to request access to your data, to rectify, erase or restrict processing, to object to processing, and the right to data portability.

Annex 2 - Declaration by the applicant.

1. The applicant declares that they intend to establish, and register, a commercial company in order to implement their business idea as described in the Application Form within the "Connect Poland Prize" project, and which has not yet been commercialised in Poland.
2. The Applicant is a natural person or an entity that has submitted an Application Form and declared that, at least on the date of signing the Grant Agreement, they will have the status of a micro or small entrepreneur, not listed on the stock exchange within five years after its registration, that meets the following conditions:
 - a) has not yet distributed any profits;
 - b) they have not taken over, or will not take over, the business of another undertaking;
 - c) has not/will not be formed as a result of a merger, and;
 - d) operates in the form of a capital company in which at least 50% of the shares are held by persons who do not hold Polish citizenship; and;
 - e) at least one member of the company's management board does not hold Polish citizenship.

The status referred to above shall result from conducting activities in the Republic of Poland, confirmed by an entry in the relevant register.

3. The Applicant declares that they have the necessary resources to achieve the Accelerator's objectives for the acceleration programme.
4. The applicant declares that they are not an entity excluded under Article 207 of the Act of 27 August 2009 on public finances (Journal of Laws of 2009, No. 157, item 1240), and in relation to the applicant there are no prerequisites as specified in:
 - a. Article 12 Paragraph 1 point 1 of the Act of 15 June 2012 on the results of employing foreigners unlawfully residing in the territory of the Republic of Poland (Journal of Laws of 2012, item 769);
 - b. Article 9(1)(2) and (2a) of the Act of 28 October 2002 on the liability of collective entities for acts prohibited under penalty (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 358, as amended);
 - c. Art. 6b par. 3 of the Act of 9 November 2000 on the establishment of the Polish Agency for Enterprise Development (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 299);
 - d. Article 37(3) of the Act of 11 July 2014 on the principles for the implementation of programmes on cohesion policy financed in the financial perspective 2014-2020 (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 818, as amended);
 - e. Article 2(18) of the EC Regulation No 651/2014 of 17 June 2014 declaring certain categories of aid compatible with the internal market in application of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty (Official Journal of the European Union L 187 of 26.06.2014, p. 1, as amended);

- f. § 4 sections 1-5 of the Ordinance of the Minister of Infrastructure and Development of 10 July 2015 on granting financial aid under the Operational Programme Intelligent Development 2014-2020 by the Polish Agency for Enterprise Development (Dz. U. of 2020, item 2133).
5. The applicant declares that he/she has full legal capacity and is entitled to full public rights.
6. The Applicant declares that he/she has read the Project Regulations and accepts their provisions.
